## NARRATIVE REPORT

Al Geer, Supervisor Southern Division

April 25, 1939

Fauntleroy "Y": This center has been carrying on a full schedule this period. The annual bean feed was a huge success this year. In this well-equipped manual shop our leader has been very busy in home craft objects, such as, flower pot stands, picture frames, etc.

Highland Park: This park was built by the civil works administration in 1932, and last year the WorksProgress Administration built a three room shelterhouse with a large meeting room and fireplace; also, a tennis court and wading pool. Now the Works Progress Administration is supervising the play activities in this field and we are using the school gym adjacent to the park. We have had a successful program here for over a year, and this center was well represented in the track meet held the 22nd of this month.

Van Asselt: This playfield was graded by the WPA and the administration built a shelterhouse identical with the one at Highland Park, and now the Works Progress Administration leaders are supervising the field. We have a splendid program going on here, also.
