Henry Peck Children's Play Area named for Henry Peck, whose efforts resulted in acquisition + development of this playfield. He emphasized that provisions for small children be included. To this purpose funds were Magnolia P.F. Assoc. (15027) and Magnolia Peck Fuel Co., member of the Magnolia Was mayor of Belland at time of Annexation.

In 1935 purchase of no. portion of P.F. was initiated by Magnolia Post of American Legion, under Henry Peck; "bought" for one dollar from King Co. - then came bill for Assessments due: \$12,000 by 1938; paid by L.I.D.

At that time area was swampy wilderness ("Pleasant Valley") drained by Wolf Creek flowing down past Magnolia Pk. WPA cleared + filled area, using locomotive end dump cars from Van Asselt P.F. + community bought play equipment.

PLAYFIELD NAME taken from community, Magnolia Bluff, which was named by Geo. Davidson in 1857, Naval Geographer, who mistook the abundant grove of Madrona trees for Magnolias. Magnolia tree named for Fr. botanist Magnol.

Smith St. probably named for Dr. Henry A. Smith, pioneer doctor and homesteader in Smith Cove area.
