## Advisory Committee

**WHAT:** Seattle Public Schools (SPS) is requesting departures from select City zoning regulations for the renovation and addition to Webster School (WS) (grade level TBD) (formerly the Nordic Heritage Museum) located at 3014 NW 67th St. SPS is requesting departures for the following:

- 1) Greater than allowed lot coverage
- 2) Greater than allowed building height
- 3) Covered play setback for noise
- 4) On-street bus loading & unloading
- 5) Reduced on-site parking

**WHO CAN APPLY:** Neighbors that live or own a business within 600' of WS, residents in the surrounding neighborhood, representatives of city-wide education issues, and potential parents of future WS students.

**WHEN / WHERE:** The committee will convene 1–3 public meetings during a 90-day period beginning when the committee is appointed. Meetings will be held at or near WS, 3014 NW 67th St.
