**WHAT:** Seattle Public Schools (SPS) is requesting departures from select City zoning regulations for the renovation and addition to Wing Luke Elementary School (WLES) located at 3701 S Kenyon St. SPS is requesting departures for the following:

- 1) Greater than allowed building height
- 2) Continued on-street bus loading and unloading
- 3) Reduced on-site parking;
- 4) Allowance of a double faced, electric changing message board

**WHO CAN APPLY:** Neighbors that live or own a business within 600' of WLES, residents in the surrounding neighborhood, representatives of city-wide education issues, PTO members, and parents of WLES students.

**WHEN / WHERE:** The committee will convene 1–3 public meetings during a 90-day period beginning when the committee is appointed. Meetings will be held at WLES, 3701 S Kenyon St.
