



N 92ND STREET PROTECTED BIKE LANE PROJECT

PROJECT OVERVIEW

We're redesigning N 92nd St to improve safety and predictability for everyone using the street, and building out the citywide multimodal transportation network. The project will add bike lanes from Wallingford Ave N to 1st Ave NE across Interstate 5, connecting people to nearby schools, parks, and businesses.

The bus stops and two travel lanes that exist today will remain. However, there are some on-street parking impacts between Wallingford Ave N and I-5. See map below and proposed cross sections on reverse.

PROJECT UPDATE

Our plans to start construction work last fall were canceled due to poor weather conditions. We are now preparing to begin construction on N 92nd St this summer.
